The East Hampton Historical Society will feature its annual house and garden tour on Thanksgiving weekend that will feature five private residences.

This year's homes include a modern one in the town of Wainscott designed by the East End architect Maziar Behrooz that features a hanging garden and an extensive art collection, and a sprawling wood frame farmhouse in Amagansett built in

1894 with several porches.

Richard Barons, executive director of the society, said the group tried to represent a variety of the architectural styles in the Hamptons, where homeowners often have the money to hire the best designers. But he said the challenge in picking five houses goes beyond just looking for strong curb appeal.

"We want houses that will be just as appealing on the inside as on the outside," he said.

The tour will take place Saturday, Nov. 24, from 1 to 4:30 p.m. Tickets are \$65 in advance and \$75 on the day of the event. Tickets for a cocktail party benefiting the historical society which will be hosted on the evening of Friday, Nov. 23, begin at \$200, a price that includes admission to the tour.
